

Prime Cattle – 10 February 2022

Total Yarding: 706

Numbers lifted and the quality was very good. Yearlings made up the bulk of the yarding and there were plenty in forward condition. There were a few weaners and a run of very heavy bullocks. Grown heifers remain in limited numbers and around 65 cows were penned.

Weaners lifted 10c to 15c with the steers 620c to 842c/kg and heifers 540c to 620c/kg. Medium weight feeder steers were firm selling from 520c to 580c and heavy weights slightly cheaper with more weight and condition on offer and ranged from 480c to 560c/kg. Feeder heifers dropped 20c with little restocking competition 460c to 540c/kg and heavy trade steers ranged from 470c to 510c/kg.

Grown steers to 600kg ranged from 435c to 440c and the bullocks 410c to 420c/kg. The lighter grown heifers to feed 380c to 430c/kg. Cows lifted 20c with the 2 score cows 300c to 330c/kg and heavy 3 and 4 score cows 310c to a top of 370c/kg.
