

Prime Cattle – 17 February 2022

Total Yarding: 869

Numbers lifted and the quality was good and weight was a feature. There were a few pens of weaners and good runs heavy feeders. Grown steers and heifers were better supplied and around 120 cows were offered. Young cattle sold from firm to dearer trends as did the grown cattle but cows softened.

Weaner steers sold from 575c to 874c/kg and heifers reached 835c/kg. Medium weight feeder steers were firm with only breed related changes and sold from 489c to 585c and heavy weights 450c to 620c/kg. Feeder heifers were firm to dearer ranging from 450c to 532c/kg. Heavy trade cattle were 20c dearer 483c to 528c/kg.

Grown steers lifted 7c and sold to 500c/kg and bullocks ranged from 415c to 470c/kg. Heavy heifers 365c to 430c/kg. Cows were back 7c to 8c and the better supplied 3 score medium weights 320c to 348c and the heavy 4 scores reached 365c/kg.
