Total Yarding: 11,603

"It was a good yarding considering the wet conditions the sheep have just been through. The better conditioned ewes sold for a premium, while there was a big gap to the lighter weight ewes. Overall, it was a satisfactory market." - Greg Anderson, MD and JJ Anderson.

10, 372 ewes were on offer, with a top price of \$354 and averaged \$253.93.

Only 112 ewes with lambs were penned, reaching a top price of \$320 to average \$289.20.

Of the 1119 ewe lambs penned the top price was \$235 with an average of \$155.61.
