

Special Store Cattle – 24 November 2022

Yarding: 729

A total of 734 head was offered and this included good runs of medium and heavy weight yearling steers and heifers and a few weaners. Cow and calf units varied in breed and condition. There was a reasonable number of buyers and the market sold to a cheaper trend with the steers easing \$150 to \$300/head and heifers slipping \$100 to \$150/head.

Light weaner steers under 200kg sold from \$920 to \$110/head. Medium and heavy weights sold mostly from \$1560 to \$1930/head. Medium weight weaner heifers reached \$1640 and heavy weights topped at \$200/head. Most of the yearling heifers sold between \$1530 and \$2060/head and the steers reached \$2130/head.

A mixed run of cow/calf unit started at \$1200 and reached \$3950/unit for Angus cows with their second calf at foot and continuously running with a bull.
